Beautiful bays nestled between rugged cliffs make the crossings between the individual islands an adventure even from the surface. With a little luck, you might spot resident humpback whales, and on the way back to Mirbat, you might even see huge schools of dolphins! The pristine Hallaniyats offer an intact underwater world with massive schools of fish and a beautiful shipwreck! Sometimes you can even encounter manta rays and mobulas there. All in all, the Hallaniyat Islands are the perfect winter destination, where you can expect one or two outstanding surprises.
