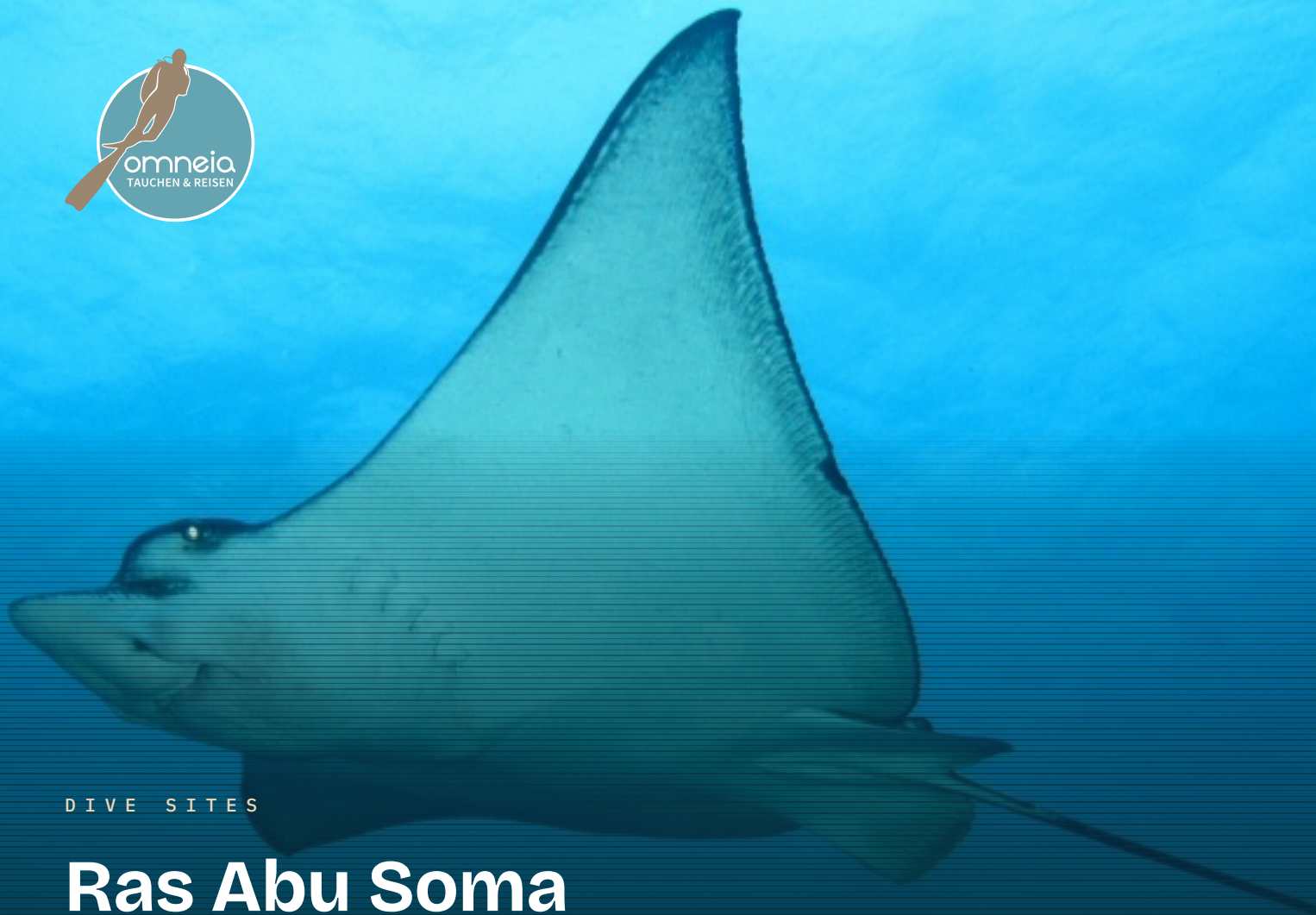

Description

This dive site is characterized by large table corals, under which large moray eels or potato groupers are often found. With a little luck, you might spot eagle rays or whitetip reef sharks here.

Ras Abu Soma Garden is a coral garden that slopes gently from 3 m to 30 m. At about 12 m, there's a large plateau with many sandy areas and coral boulders. The sandy bottom between the coral blocks is anything but boring—it's easy to overlook the perfectly camouflaged crocodilefish or torpedo rays.
