Diving at Daedalus Reef (Abu Kzian) with its striking lighthouse. No Japanese-style "rushing from one reef to the next," but simply staying where it's most beautiful—and searching for hammerhead sharks! **A liveaboard** for experienced divers.

Under Egyptian law, night dives are not permitted at Daedalus, and a minimum of 50 logged dives is required.

Here you'll find dive sites along this route. Which sites are actually visited depends on the port from which your liveaboard departs and on current weather conditions.
